How to Choose the Right Life Jacket

Looking for a life jacket? Today's jackets come in a variety of shapes, sizes, colours, and materials. No matter which life jacket you choose, be sure it's right for YOU, your planned activities, and the water conditions you expect to encounter.

Two popular types of life jackets used onboard are:

Inflatable Life Jacket:

This jacket needs inflation for buoyancy and is automatically inflated when immersed in water. It normally consists of two different buoyancy compartments. Inflatable life jackets have the advantage of being light to wear with ease of movement.

Suitable for yachting, sports/power boating, angling, aviation, and industrial use. An inflatable life jacket is designed to remain compact until full buoyancy is needed.

Inherently Buoyant Life Jacket:

These jackets are fitted with buoyant materials and they don't need to be inflated.

Permanent buoyancy is achieved using soft PVC closed cell foam. All outer covers are brightly coloured and are aided by retroreflective tape which makes them highly visible both in and out of the water. Whistles are attached.

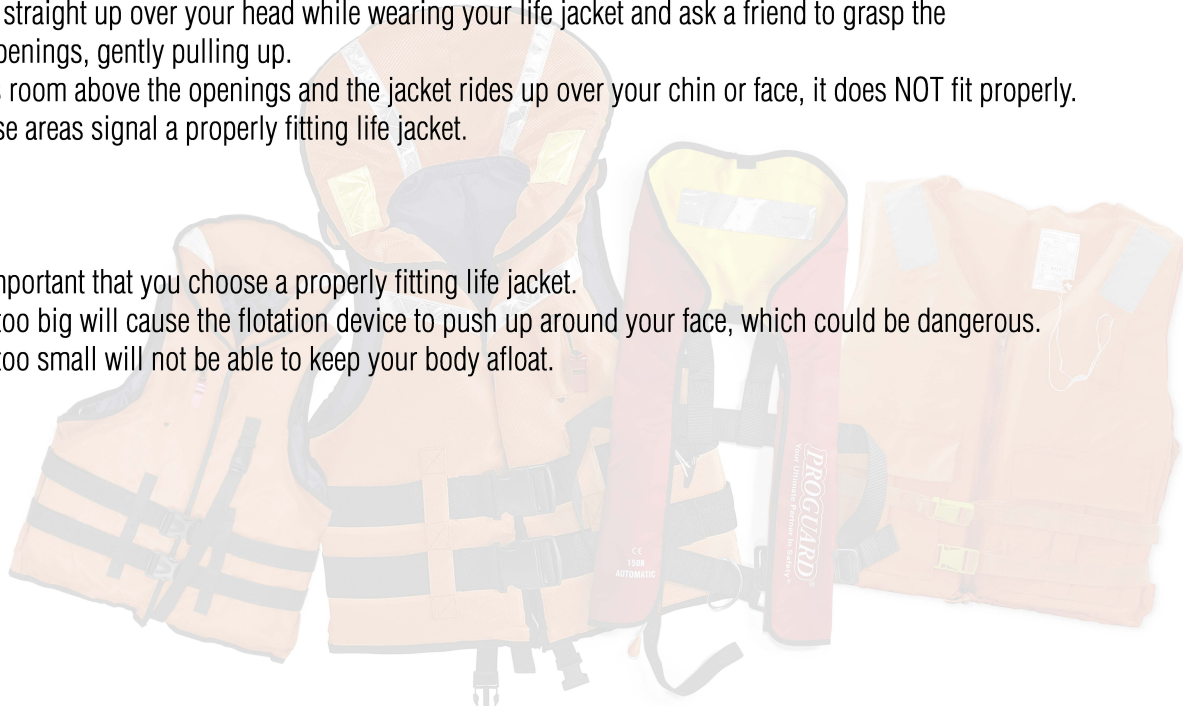
While in the water, the jackets neck collar will provide additional support and keep the head afloat above water. Crotch straps are provided as standard.

Check the manufacturer's ratings for your size and weight

- Make sure the jacket is properly zipped or buckled.
- Raise your arms straight up over your head while wearing your life jacket and ask a friend to grasp the top of the arm openings, gently pulling up.
- If there is excess room above the openings and the jacket rides up over your chin or face, it does NOT fit properly. A snug fit in these areas signal a properly fitting life jacket.

Fit Facts

- It is extremely important that you choose a properly fitting life jacket.
- Jackets that are too big will cause the flotation device to push up around your face, which could be dangerous.
- Jackets that are too small will not be able to keep your body afloat.
